The half-day program is 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. or 12:15 p.m. to 3:15 p.m. and the full-day program is 8:30 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.

Applications for new students will be held until March 15 to allow current students to be re-enrolled during February. In March, we will admit students from among already-received applications as space allows. Be sure to register early as date of application may be important.
