Enrollment Begins in January

We are now accepting applications for kindergartners and for new students for preschool through grade eight for the 2010-11 school year. **This includes new students from current families.** We will be offering a full-day kindergarten and a half-day kindergarten program for the 2010-11 school year.

Current families will receive re-enrollment forms in February to be used for currently-enrolled students only. Parents of three-and four-day preschoolers have already received kindergarten applications. Please remember to state your preference when making application. The half-day program is 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. or 12:15 p.m. to 3:15 p.m., and the full-day program is 8:30 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.
