



OVERVIEW

The new Head of School at LCA will be stepping into an incredible opportunity of Christian leadership and impact on an organization that God has blessed and sustained for fifty years. He/she will not only assume the educational and operational leadership of the school, but more importantly, will set the tone for the spiritual growth and development of our students, faculty, and staff. We are looking for the individual who not only possesses the ability to lead in this capacity, but it is fueled by growth in these areas.

The Head of School reports to the Board of Directors as their sole employee. Consistent with its *Policy Governance Model*, the Board is responsible for the school's long-term mission and vision and delegates all day-to-day operations through explicit governing policies to the Head of School. Our board recognizes the great opportunities, as well as the challenging responsibilities for the next Head of School, and is fully committed to supporting the administration and faculty of our school.

LCA is a partnering ministry of <u>Cedar Crest Bible Fellowship Church</u>. Though we are two separate entities with cooperative interaction, we share the same space and passion to see lives changed for Jesus Christ. To that end, our next Head of School will need to be in a cooperative and aligned relationship with the church — understanding that a healthy relationship with the church is a key component to the flourishing and vibrancy of our Christian school ministry.

Currently reporting to the Head of School are the Elementary and Secondary Principals, the Office Manager, the Director of Development, the Director of Athletics, and the Director of Information Technology.

RESPONSIBILITIES

SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP

The Head of School provides spiritual leadership through a powerful Christian testimony and witness, a humble spirit, and a heart guided by prayer. He or she is responsible for ensuring students can grow and develop with the foundation of God's truth, and for fostering the spiritual vitality of the faculty and staff so they can positively influence students. He or she will model a Christ-like attitude and lifestyle; and demonstrate compassion, patience, honesty, and wisdom in all interactions with staff, students, parents, board members, and other community members.

ADVANCEMENT & FINANCIAL LEADERSHIP

The Head of School will enthusiastically promote LCA to the broader Lehigh Valley community, enhancing the school's reputation to increase enrollment and donor giving. He or she monitors enrollment trends and seeks to understand what is driving those trends. He or she also oversees the operation of the business office including IT, accounting/finance, communications, and development. As the face of the school, the Head of School serves as the chief development officer and aggressively pursues donor cultivation.

ORGANIZATION LEADERSHIP

The Head of School provides strategic, visionary direction, recommends goals to the Board, promotes approved goals and diligently oversees the implementation of them. He or she collaborates with and supervises the leadership team, ensuring they effectively lead all other staff in the accomplishment of strategic goals and initiatives for the purpose of fulfilling the LCA mission and vision.

COMMUNICATION SKILLS

The Head of School will be a unifying and effective communicator who establishes and maintains strong personal relationships with internal and external constituents. The Head of School will be an intentional and willing listener; seeking to hear and learn from those whom they lead. ACADEMIC LEADERSHIP
